

Subscriptions / Auto-Renewal Terms

Monthly Workspace Subscription

GRIT is sold as a monthly recurring workspace subscription.

Your selected plan grants access to the features and limits associated with that package.

Automatic Renewal

Subscriptions automatically renew each billing cycle unless canceled before renewal.

You authorize recurring charges through Stripe until canceled.

Billing Timing

Billing occurs on the recurring date associated with your original purchase or subsequent plan reset date.

Applicable taxes may be added where required by law and will be displayed at checkout or invoice.

Customer Self-Service Billing Portal

Customers may manage subscriptions through the Stripe customer portal, including:

- payment methods
- invoices
- receipts
- upgrades
- downgrades
- cancellations

Cancellations

If canceled, service remains active through the end of the current paid billing period.

Your subscription will then terminate unless reactivated.

No future renewal charge will occur after valid cancellation.

Upgrades

Plan upgrades are effective immediately.

Charges may be prorated and/or credits applied based on Stripe billing logic at the time of upgrade.

Downgrades

Plan downgrades are effective immediately if supported by current Stripe billing configuration.

If Stripe applies credits, adjustments, or billing changes, those will govern.

If future billing-cycle downgrades are implemented, GRIT may update these terms accordingly.

Failed Payments

If a renewal payment fails, Stripe may retry charges using its retry tools.

GRIT may limit or suspend access if payment is not resolved.

Price Changes

We may change subscription pricing or plan structure with prior notice.
